

3 on 3 Tournament Rules

THE GOAL OF THIS EVENT IS TO HAVE A GOOD TIME, AND TO RAISE MONEY FOR THE BASKETBALL TEAM. **THIS IS NOT THE NBA FINALS: CUSSING, PLAYING DIRTY, AND ARGUING WITH THE REFS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**

- Each Game will be decided by the first team to reach 21 or whoever is leading after 15 minutes.
- The tournament will be a double elimination tournament. Once your team loses twice, then they will be eliminated from the tournament.
- The Clock will be a running clock. No teams will be given timeouts.
- We recommend that you have at least 4 players on a team in case someone is injured or has to leave the tournament; however, 3 man teams will be allowed. No more than 6 players will be allowed to a team roster.
- Subs will be allowed during a dead ball situation.
- Females will be allowed to play if they want to.
- A player may not play for more than one team.
- If for some reason a team does not have 3 players for a game, then they will be allowed to get someone from the crowd or another team. However, if a team uses a player that is on another roster, then the game result will automatically end in a loss even if they win.
- The games will consist of 2's and 3's.
- If there is a foul on the floor, then the ball will be checked up top. If there is a foul during the shot then the offense will get 1 point and the ball back.
- The defensive team will gain possession after a made basket (No make it, take it).
- Each possession will start with a check to the opposing team. After that, the offensive team will be required to pass the ball in.
- If the ball hits the rim, then the defensive team will be required to take the ball outside the 3 point line before they can score. If there is a steal or an airball, then the defensive team is not required to take the ball outside of the 3 point line.
- If there is a tie at the end of 15 minutes then the game will be decided by a sudden death free throw shootout.
- There will be a 30 second shot clock inside of 2 minutes. Teams that are winning will not be allowed to hold the ball until the game ends.
